I can't quite believe where the time has gone! Sorry this prayer letter is so late - I ended up being extremely busy before Flame arrived on Sat 30 April for 2 wks *and* my laptop died, having to have a new hard drive. I hosted a Royal Wedding party which was great fun!



The 2 Flame Conferences in Matana and Muyinga were superb. I think they were the best yet. Matana was challenging at first but by the end delegates testified to how much God had done in their lives. Burundi personal living and ministry costs

In April I showed a pie chart of my total budget. Here's the annual budget just for my Burundi personal living and ministry costs. I pay around £1200 / year for our trauma healing training events and contributions for my volunteers' time. The workers' salaries include guards 24 hours a day, an indoor worker, 80% of all their healthcare costs, a savings scheme for them and annual gifts.
